1. Access my worldview

2. Accept Christ as my Savior

3. Admit your need for obedience

4. Apply God's Word to your daily life

*¹⁷ Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth.
John 17:17*

Start Doing:

You'll have access to thousands of bible study and spiritual development resources.
- Consider a few things you can do with the people in your group to develop a more consistent biblical worldview. Some examples might be reading a book on theology together, meeting one-on-one with someone of the same gender to pray and read Scripture together outside the group, or listening to Christian podcasts as you drive.

Start Praying: Pray that God would help you see all things as He does, to rejoice in what He rejoices in and avoid the things He hates. Ask for God to give you a distinctly biblical worldview.
