Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus... (Philippians 2:3-5)



Start Talking:

- What was the silliest argument you ever got in? What was it about?

Start Sharing

- Have you ever been in a disagreement and realized you were wrong? What was it like to admit you were wrong?
- Admitting our personal mistakes is one aspect of being humble. What are some other things that come to mind when you think of someone who is humble?
- Can you think of a time that pride/ego got the best of you? If you could relive that moment, what would you do differently?

Read – Philippians 2:3-8 – Paul's prescription for living in unity with one another.

- What does it mean to truly put the interests of others ahead of our own?
- What are some of the obstacles of putting other's interest ahead of our own?
- Why is understanding Jesus' sacrifice an important part of understanding humility?

Start Doing:

- If you are in a disagreement with someone currently, what are some ways you can display humility in the situation?
- What are some ways your life group can hold each other accountable to live like Jesus and help create a culture of humility?
