



## Talk it Over Guide DNA – Who We Are - Week 1 Biblical Authority

### Start Talking:

- What is your view of the Bible? Have you or anyone around you questioned the accuracy of the Bible? What does, “inspired by God” mean?

### Start Sharing

- With all the skepticism about the Bible, how can you defend the Bible?
- Read 1 Peter 3:15. What do you think Peter is prescribing here? How can we be better prepared to defend what we believe through the Bible?
- Can you think of a time that reading the Bible dramatically helped you in a time of struggle? How did it help?

### Read – Hebrews 4:12 – Further description of the Bible.

- What do you think “alive and powerful” means as the author of Hebrews uses it to describe the Bible?
- How does the Bible expose our innermost thoughts and feelings?

### Start Doing:

- Jesus said in Mark 12:24 that it is a mistake to not know the Bible and that knowing the Bible allows us to learn and experience the power of God. How can we value the Bible better by learning it more so that we can apply it to our lives?
- What are some ways your life group can hold each other accountable to not only learn the Bible, but to also apply it and live it out each day?
