Icebreaker Question

What's the best compliment you can give to someone?

The Verse

Ephesians 2:8-9

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.

Big Question

Why should you share grace with everyone?

Choose some questions to discuss with your kids:

1. What stood out to you the most from the message? What's one thing you learned?
2. Who makes it challenging for you to show grace to them? Why do you think it's especially hard for you to be gracious to this person?
3. Read Ephesians 2:8-9 NLT. What do you have to do to be good enough to earn God's grace? (Nothing!) What would it be like if everyone were gracious to others the way God is gracious?
4. Today, we learned three ways to show grace to the world: Be generous; build each other up; and forgive with ease. Which of these is hardest for you? Which do you think you're doing a pretty good job at? How can you get better at doing all three regularly?
5. What does it show the world when Christians tear each other down, don't forgive one another, and don't help one another?
6. What can you do—this week—to boost God's grace in your home, neighborhood, or school?
7. Pray together. Pray that your child realizes how amazing God's grace is. Pray they would want to share that same gracious attitude toward everyone they know and meet.
