Start Talking:

- Share one event or experience in which you were an eyewitness.

Start Sharing

- Do you feel like you have a story to share, why or why not?
- We heard on Sunday, “When my **fear** is greater than my **desire** to share, I won’t.” What fear keeps you from sharing your story?
- On Sunday we heard about two **YOU WILL** statements from Jesus to His believers, how does that change or adjust the way you feel about sharing your story?

Read – Romans 1:16

- What do you think the writer meant by saying “I am not ashamed...”? Are there parts of your story or God’s story that you are ashamed of?
- Have you ever shared your story with someone, which led to sharing God’s story with someone?
- **DON’T MISS THIS:** *Is your story clear?* Consider completing the “My Story” form on our website <https://brevardcommunity.org/mystory/>, if you haven’t already.

Start Doing:

- Try this: Have one person share their story with the group and encourage anyone that doesn’t think they have a story to make Next Moves by talking with their Leader, or completing an Online Care Card so that someone can follow up with them.

If the Samaritan woman could share a 2 sentence story with the rest of her village, and God’s power can use that to produce life change, then we have no excuse not to share!
