### Start Talking:

- Growing up, what was Easter like for you? How did Easter 2020 go for you and your family?

### Start Sharing

- When was the last time you were surprised by something that was completely unexpected?
- The four Gospels focus on the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. When you think of Jesus, which of those three words come to mind the most?
- On Easter we heard “without the resurrection, the story of Jesus isn’t worth telling.” How do you feel about that statement? In your own words how would you explain that to someone?

### Read – *John 20:1-8, 24-29*

- What stands out to you about these passages?
- Who can you relate to most from these passages: Peter, John, or Thomas? What makes you say that?
- When people saw that Jesus rose from the dead they Believed that he was the Messiah and they believed in him as the Lord of their life. Why do you think Jesus called people—like us—who were not eyewitnesses to the resurrection “blessed”?

### Start Doing:

- What is God calling you to do this week to show the love of Christ to people who don’t know Him? Take time to pray for those people as a group.
