Start Talking:

- Who is someone you know that isn't afraid to be bold?

Start Sharing

- On a scale of 1 – 10 how bold do you think you naturally are?
- We heard on Sunday, “we can choose intimidation or impact.” In your own words, talk about how that choice impacts your life.
- Talk about a recent time when you had an opportunity to share your faith or were bold for Jesus.

Read – Acts 5:12-25

- This story takes place after the followers of Jesus prayed for boldness in the face of opposition. Note the big events in the story:
 1. the disciples performed miracles and taught people about Jesus
 2. they were arrested
 3. they were miraculously set free and told to go back and keep being bold...
- The disciples wanted to make a difference for Jesus more than they wanted to be safe. Why do you think the disciples cared more about impact than comfort?
- Consider the results of the disciples' boldness—thousands of lives were changed forever. What would it look like for you to choose boldness over comfort?

Start Doing:

- **Don't miss this:** Think about your “someone.” What opportunities do you have to be bold in your faith this coming week?

Prayer:

Father, thanks to You, we don't have to live a life of fear. You give us the boldness to overcome any obstacle that comes our way. Help us to trust You no matter how difficult life seems, and to step forward in obedience, knowing You'll always be with us. In Jesus' name, amen.
