### **Start Talking:**

- Did you ever notice that your passenger side mirror was different from the driver’s side?
- Would you normally see a glass half full, or a glass half empty?

### **Start Sharing**

- Would you say that you have experienced more POSITIVE or NEGATIVE circumstances in your life?
- On Sunday we heard that everyone has forces pushing against their perspective. What force do you feel like exerts the most pressure and weight against yours? Why?

### **Read – Philippians 4:4**

- When you say something twice in a short period of time, what does that usually mean to others?
- What does rejoicing in the Lord look like to you? What does “always” mean to you after hearing the message?
- How does the following phrase effect you? “The choice to rejoice will often go against how we feel. It is a choice, not a feeling”

### **Start Doing:**

- Paul stated that he always gave thanks to God for Faithful Work, Loving Deeds, and Enduring Hope. This is all about WHAT God is doing, so is your Thanksgiving wall or board up yet? Can you share something you have already written down?
- We learned that rejoicing in the Lord is all about WHO God is and his character. What was something in the [Names of God](#) resource that has helped you rejoice in WHO He is?
