Start Talking:

- What’s something of significant value that you have that people wouldn’t recognize as valuable just by looking at it?

Start Sharing

- The God of “Moral Therapeutic Deism” requires nothing and expects nothing of his followers He blesses but does not discipline, tips his hat of favor but does not rebuke. Is this similar to your understanding of God?
- Many people live a life where they admire Jesus but don’t worship him. What is the difference between those in your own words?
- Do you know anyone who admires Jesus but does not worship him? In what ways can you help them understand the true nature of following Jesus?

Read – Acts 5:10-11

- What’s your initial reaction to the account of Ananias and Sapphira? What significance does this story have to your life?
- Why do you think people get uncomfortable when talking about sacrificing money?
- We talked on Sunday about how ordinary sources of security and significance are obstacles to following Jesus. What do you think is your source of security and/or significance that God wants you to sacrifice for his sake?

Start Doing:

- Seriously take your time and consider this question deeply: am I “all-in” in my commitment to following Jesus, or am I holding something back?
- Counting the cost: The antidote to a superficial life is sacrificial living. How does God want you to live more sacrificially?

Don’t let the conversation stop. Keep talking it over with others in a GROUP.
