Start Talking:

Read – John 17:20-23

- What stands out to you?
- In verse 23, Jesus prays for unity. How would you define “unity”? What’s the difference between “unity” and “uniformity?”
- According to Jesus’s prayer, why is unity so important?

Start Doing:

- When it comes to disagreeing politically and loving unconditionally, what’s the next step for you?
