



Talk It Over Guide The Book of Colossians– Week 1



⁶ This same Good News that came to you is going out all over the world. It is bearing fruit everywhere by changing lives, just as it changed your lives from the day you first heard and understood the truth about God's wonderful grace. Colossians 1:6

Start Talking:

- In the book of Colossians, Paul is writing to a group of people he has never met before. Imagine this scenario: someone wanted you to talk to some of their friends (that you've never met) to get them back on the right track in life...what would you say?

Start Sharing

- Have you ever been in a position to explain your Christian faith to someone? How did that experience go?
- Do you feel like you know how to explain the gospel to someone else? What would you share?
- Are there things that people add to the gospel that shouldn't be there? What are some of those things?

Read – Romans 1:16-17

- According to Romans, why is the Gospel a big deal?
- What is the difference between “Self-help” and the Gospel?
- How has the Gospel changed your life?

Start Doing:

Consider the 3 questions that Stewart asked on Sunday.

- Have I understood the Gospel?
- Have I believed the Gospel?
- Have I been transformed by the Gospel?

Do you believe you can say yes to all three? Why or why not?
