



Talk It Over Guide The Book of Colossians– Week 2



Christ is the visible image of the invisible God.

He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation. Colossians 1:15

Start Talking:

- How is the word “supreme” used in our culture? (supreme pizza, the Supreme Leader in Star Wars, Supreme Court, etc.)
- With those examples in mind, how would you say our world defines “supreme?”

Start Sharing

- How would someone who is not a Christian answer the question “who is Jesus?”
- How would you answer the question “who is Jesus?”
- How does our understanding of Jesus shape our beliefs and behaviors?

Read – Colossians 1:15-23

- What is your biggest take away from these verses? What stands out most to you?
- How did Jesus display the nature and character of God while he was on Earth?
- Jesus is God. As God, he is supreme over creation and sufficient for salvation. How can your life reflect the supremacy and sufficiency of Christ?

Start Doing:

- Based on the verses we read, it is important to understand that Jesus is in authority over our lives and he is always worthy of worship and devotion—regardless of how uncomfortable our circumstances are.
 - Therefore, what does it look like for you to live under the authority of Jesus? Are there any areas of your life that are not living under his authority?
 - How can your life reflect worship and devotion to Jesus? How can you choose to worship Jesus even in the midst of painful or difficult seasons?
